SALT RIVER PIMA-MARICOPA INDIAN COMMUNITY – In partnership with the Arizona Diamondbacks and the Colorado Rockies, Salt River Fields at Talking Stick will host press on site at Salt River Fields to photograph installation of sod at Salt River Fields at **10 a.m. Wednesday, June 30**.
